

Evidence and rationale that the proposals meet the three statutory criteria			
<p>It is proposed to create a division from the majority of the Old Sarum area of what was the Laverstock, Ford and Old Sarum Division, along with the developed and planned development areas at Bishopdown Farm and Longhedge. As this is predominantly newer housing it is the area of the parish with the most logical community connection and lacks other areas to be joined with as the parish as a whole is too large for a single Division and it is not considered appropriate on a community level to combine the area with the city parish. The older part of the parish in Division 24 is therefore included with the more rural parishes to the east and south.</p>

Evidence and rationale that the proposals meet the three statutory criteria

It is proposed to take the older established housing inside the Parish of Laverstock and Ford into a division with Clarendon Park, Firsdawn, Britford and Odstock. The main logic here is geographical connectivity of a lot of small parishes. Firsdawn and Clarendon Park have clear historic and road links to Laverstock. Britford and Clarendon Park are linked to an extent, being small older communities on either side of the Avon. Odstock is linked to Britford and should be retained in the same division. Given the geographic scale of Clarendon Park combined with its small electorate which cannot be divided, no other alternatives to create a division in this area had as limited an impact on other parishes.
