The quickest way to receive your £150 energy rebate

If you pay your council tax by direct debit, Wiltshire Council will use your bank details to pay the rebate straight in to your account. This is the quickest way to receive your rebate.

Paying council tax by direct debit is safe, simple and quick. To set up a direct debit visit www.wiltshire.gov.uk/benefits-council-tax.

If you don't pay your council tax by direct debit look out for a letter in the post

If you are eligible for the energy rebate but don't pay your council tax by direct debit, you will receive a letter through the post inviting you to submit your bank details via the Wiltshire Council website. This will ensure the rebate can be paid into your bank account.

You do not need to call us; we will write to you before the end of April.

If you do not pay council tax

Some households in Wiltshire that do not pay council tax because they receive a council tax reduction but are eligible for the energy rebate. We will be writing to these households and inviting them to provide their bank details so that the rebate can be paid to them.

Properties in council tax bands E – H

The Government has given the council a discretionary fund to help households on low incomes who live in properties in bands E-H. Visit the Wiltshire Council website for further information about the scheme.
